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PROGRAM NARRATIVE:

In recent years the visual presence of street level drug sales has diminished. Violators have migrated towards the use of cellular phones to help facilitate their illegal drug distribution. It has been in our local experience that the drug violators prefer to have telephone contact with their clients prior to their meeting which is normally established over the phone. In almost all instances individuals who distribute illegal drugs are involved in some sort of conspiracy. Violators who use cellular phones have instant access to their suppliers, distributors and clients. In order to help combat this merge, specialized equipment is necessary to effectively obtain intelligence and evidence for successful prosecution of these violators who sometimes operate as Drug Trafficking Organizations.

PROJECT SUMMARY:

Once obtained and installed, the computer software will allow access through a secured router to a Specified Location Point. At which time the agency will be able to collect telephone information such as Caller-ID, subscriber information, out-going number dialed, in-coming numbers calling, length of phone call, and the general geographical location where the target was located while calling. This will help identify suspects and associates, help locate areas of stored illegal drugs, and help create a link between all identified parties involved in illegal drug distribution rings. In order to obtain this information this specialized will be purchased so that upon successfully obtaining the proper court ordered requirements the specialized equipment can be activated. Once activation is complete information can be immediately collected and analyzed. Once the information is obtained the requested Scanner will be used to help disseminate the information to proper personnel. The program manager will track the grant-related productivity of the program officers on a monthly basis to ensure that grant remain on target.

Grant funds will be managed in a manner consistent with acceptable, contemporary procurement and accounting policies, guidelines and practices of the City of Fort Walton Beach. All drawdowns and grant expenditures will be maintained and tracked separately from other federal funding. Grant funds will be deposited into the existing law enforcement trust fund, where it will remain pending distribution per terms of the agreement.

BUDGET NARRATIVE:

Grants funds under this initiative will be utilized to procure telephonic intercept user software intercept version with GIS mapping, a router with ten tunnels, and a scanning device.
