JOB SUMMARY

Semi-skilled work involving basic cleaning and maintenance of lift stations and wastewater collection systems. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Sewer Collections Supervisor.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Performs routine maintenance on wastewater collection system and lift stations.
- Inspects lift stations, manholes, and sewer system.
- Installs and repairs sanitary sewer lines, lift stations, pumps, manholes, and all related facilities.
- Digs and refills ditches, loads dirt and construction materials using light to heavy motorized equipment.
- Operates combination sewer jet truck in cleaning operations of sewers, lift-stations & storm drains.
- Assists with CCTV inspections of sewer and stormwater systems.
- Performs duties as an emergency on-call and stand-by operator/technician on a weekly rotating schedule.
- Responds to emergency calls for service after-hours.
- Prepares field notes and activity reports.
- Performs other job duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS

Education and Experience:

Two (2) years of experience in heavy manual labor and the use of hand and light power tools.

Special Qualifications:

- Possession of a valid State of Florida Driver's License to operate the motor vehicle operated; typically Class B with Tanker endorsement.
- Possession of Wastewater Collection System Certified Operator Level "C" required within six (6) months of hire.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of materials, methods, practices, and equipment used in the wastewater field.
- Knowledge of the layout and location of City streets, sewer lines, and lift stations.
- Ability to perform basic mechanical and electrical repairs.
- Ability to communicate verbally.
- Ability to operate specialized equipment.
- Ability to prepare written reports and maintain records.
- Ability to follow complex oral and written instructions.
- Ability to read maps and technical drawings.
- Ability to use complex mathematical formulas.
- Ability to work without direct supervision.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

The work is heavy work which requires exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects. Additionally, the following physical abilities are required:

- Climbing: Ascending or descending ladders, stairs, scaffolding, ramps, poles and the like, using feet and legs and/or hands and arms. Body agility is emphasized.
- Crawling: Moving about on hands and knees or hands and feet.
- Crouching: Bending the body downward and forward by bending leg and spine.
- Feeling: Perceiving attributes of objects, such as size, shape, temperature or texture by touching with skin, particularly that of fingertips.
- Fingering: Picking, pinching, typing, or otherwise working, primarily with fingers rather than with the whole hand as in handling.
- Grasping: Applying pressure to an object with the fingers and palm.
- Handling: Picking, holding, or otherwise working, primarily with the whole hand.
- Hearing 1: Perceiving the nature of sounds at normal speaking levels with or without correction. Ability to receive detailed information through oral communication, and to make the discrimination in sound.
- Hearing 2: Ability to receive detailed information through oral communication, and to make the discrimination in sound.
- Kneeling: Bending legs at knee to come to a rest on knee or knees.
- Lifting: Raising objects from a lower to a higher position or moving objects horizontally from position-to-position. Occurs to a considerable degree and requires substantial use of upper extremities and back muscles.
- Mental Acuity: Ability to make rational decisions through sound logic and deductive processes.

- Pulling: Using upper extremities to exert force in order to draw, haul or tug objects in a sustained motion.
- Standing: Particularly for sustained periods of time.
- Talking 1: Expressing or exchanging ideas by means of the spoken word including those
 activities in which they must convey detailed or important spoken instructions to other
 workers accurately, loudly, or quickly.
- Talking 2: Shouting in order to be heard above ambient noise level.
- Visual Acuity 1: Have close visual acuity to perform an activity such as: preparing and analyzing data and figures; transcribing; viewing a computer terminal; and/or extensive reading.
- Visual Acuity 2: Including color, depth perception, and field vision.
- Visual Acuity 3: Visual Acuity to determine the accuracy, neatness, and thoroughness of the work assigned or to make general observations of facilities or structures.
- Visual Acuity 4: Have visual acuity to operate motor vehicles and/or heavy equipment.
- Visual Acuity 5: Have close visual acuity to perform an activity such as: visual inspection involving small defects, small parts, operation of machines; using measurement devices; and/or assembly or fabrication parts at distances close to the eyes.
- Walking: Moving about on foot to accomplish tasks, particularly for long distances or moving from one work site to another.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- Work is performed primarily in outdoors in all weather conditions.
- May be exposed to confined space entry, chemicals, electricity, around light power equipment, slippery surfaces, below ground level – 26', odors, climbs ladders, heights (up to 60 feet), and use of self-contained breathing apparatus.
