Commercial Garbage Service (Blue Dumpster)

Commercial garbage is scheduled per the customer's needs and the fee is based on the frequency and container size. **All garbage generated at the business should be placed inside the dumpster. (NO exceptions)** Cooking oil, building materials, concrete, bricks, solvents, paint, ashes and other hazardous waste should not be placed inside the dumpster. **Any debris or garbage disposed of around the dumpster or enclosure will be subject to a charge.**

Commercial Recycling (Yellow Dumpster)

Commercial recycling is scheduled per the customer's needs and the fee is based on frequency and container size. **Please break down Cardboard boxes to maximize space.** Please do not place yard waste in the container. **Contamination and debris disposed of around the dumpster or enclosure will be subject to a charge and suspension of recycling privileges.** For more information about Commercial recycling, please call (850) 833-9655.

Commercial Yard Waste

The City does not offer Commercial Yard Waste service. Commercial Yard Waste must be placed in the dumpster. If it is too large for the dumpster, a special pick up must be scheduled. Yard waste is charged based on either time or weight. Please call (850) 833-9655 for more information about this service.

Hazardous Waste

To dispose of cooking oil, old paint, fertilizer, pesticides or other Hazardous Waste, please call (850) 301-2013. They are open 7AM to 3PM, Tuesday thru Saturday without appointment and are located at 80 Ready Avenue NW.

Commercial Bulk Waste

Commercial debris that is too large for the dumpster must be scheduled. Please call (850) 833-9655. We do not pick up construction debris, concrete, glass or tires. There is a minimum charge of \$30.00 and a maximum of \$180.00 per hour.
